CULTURE/ARTS

- Maui Film Festival takes place in Wailea in June.
- Old Lahaina Luau is as close to the real thing as you can get.
- Ulalena is a contemporary portrayal of the story of Hawaii told through modern dance and Hawaiian music located in Lahaina.

EXPLORATION

- Maui Ocean Center, which has one of the world's largest fish tanks with live sharks and giant rays.
- Wailea Beach, which fronts the hotel, has been named the #1 beach in America by Dr. Beach. A popular destination because of its location and gentle waves vs. other beaches.
- Beach walk, also fronting the resort, spans a total of 3 miles from one end to the other starting at the Renaissance to Polo Beach. This is a great ocean front walk which allows you to see most of the resorts in Wailea from the path.
- Big Beach or Makena Beach is also very popular and is approximately a 1 mile stretch of white sand. This beach gives you a great view of Molokini and Kaho'olawe.
- Paia, a laid back surfer town with small coffee shops and boutiques, is a great stop on the way to Hana.
- The Ali'i Lavender Farm in Kula is a unique experience.
- Whale watching tours are popular from December – April.
- Our own 5 acre pool complex with water elevator, slides, jacuzzi's, winding canyon, rapids and grotto bar.
- Ocean side massages at sunset on Wailea Beach can be arranged upon request.

KIDS/TEENS

- Camp Grande for kids ages 5-12, allows them to partake in activities from lawn games, painting coconuts, to kite and lei making.
- Fun for teens including Co-Ed Teen Spa or Teen Dance during high season and holidays

- OFF-PROPERTY ACTIVITIES

- Biking down a volcano (the crater is big enough to fit the Island of Manhattan in it with room to spare), with the ride starting at dawn with a spectacular sunset view from atop the mountain.

DINING/ENTERTAINMENT

- Cabana dining – arrange a private menu and dinner in one of our poolside cabanas (24 hour advance notice and cost is approximately \$500).
- Lahaina and Kaanapali offer nightlife in the way of clubs, pubs, restaurants and more live music.
- Wailea Spagos is always popular dining spot because of the potential celebrity sightings.
- Capishe restaurant at Diamond Resort has a tranquil garden area and sunset views.
- Seawatch restaurant at the Wailea Golf Course has spectacular views.

UNIQUE HOTEL FACTS

- The aquarium in the Humu lounge area holds 2,100 gallons of water and is the largest on Maui.
- The lagoon holds 700,000 gallons of water.
- The total number of tiles used in the Crossroads Mosaic in the lower lobby Grand Dining Room area by Yvonne Cheng is 204,600. She also did the windows in the Chapel.
- The water elevator rises and falls 18 feet and is the only one of its kind in the world.
- The statue of King Kamehameha is one of five in the world and the only one on Maui. Four statues are in Hawaii and one in the Smithsonian in Washington, DC.
- King Kamehameha Day is June 11th, and we hold an annual celebration here at Grand Wailea Resort.
